MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE NEW MEXICO HEALTH POLICY COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRI ATI ON. --

Five hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$575,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New Mexico health policy commission for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 in the following amounts for the following purposes:

(1) one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000) to establish a centralized data system to track the geographic availability of health services, to assess the effectiveness of existing initiatives, to give priority based on need to geographic areas and health professions and to identify opportunities to improve current resources;
