20	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance

The 6 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the state department of public education for the purpose of 7 acquiring and installing educational computer technology at 8 9 Vaughn municipal schools located in Guadalupe county.
