18	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
19	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding forty-eight thousand
20	seven hundred fifty dollars (\$48,750) when the state engineer
21	certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state
22	board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the
23	bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible
24	upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed
