AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES: CLARIFYING THE PURPOSE OF A SEVERANCE TAX BOND APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT FOR WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS IN CERRILLOS IN SANTA FE COUNTY: MAKING AN APPROPRIATION: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--DEPARTMENT OF Section 1. ENVIRONMENT -- CHANGE IN PURPOSE -- APPROPRIATION. -- The balance of severance tax bonds appropriated to the department of environment pursuant to Subsection TT of Section 6 of Chapter 4 of Laws 1996 (1st S.S.) for the purpose of designing, constructing or inspecting a new water storage tank and related water system improvements in the village of Cerrillos located in Santa Fe county shall not be expended for its original purpose but is reauthorized and appropriated to the department of

environment for the purpose of designing, constructing or inspecting water system improvements in the village of Cerrillos located in Santa Fe county.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
