AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYEES; AUTHORIZING INCENTIVE AWARDS FOR EMPLOYEES WHOSE INVESTMENT EXPERTISE SIGNIFICANTLY CONTRIBUTES TO INCREASED EARNINGS FROM INVESTMENT OF PUBLIC FUNDS; REQUIRING A WRITTEN INCENTIVE AWARD POLICY; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 10-7-12 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1986, Chapter 39, Section 1) is amended to read:

"10-7-12. GOVERNMENT COST SAVINGS <u>OR INCREASED RETURNS</u>
INCENTIVE AWARD. --

- A. As used in this section:
- (1) "actual cost savings" means realized, not projected, cost savings substantiated by documentation;
 - (2) "award" means a government cost savings

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- (3) "economy" includes maximizing the purchasing value of public funds;
- (4) "efficiency" includes a significant reduction in paperwork and the elimination of unnecessary rules, regulations and procedures; [and]
- (5) "increased returns" means earnings from the investment of public funds that outperform generally accepted market indexes for the same or similar types of investments; and

[(5)] (6) "state agency" means any office, department, institution, school district, board, commission, court, district attorney, council or committee of state government which receives appropriations and is authorized expenditures pursuant to a general appropriation act.

B. A state agency may <u>establish a policy to</u> provide an award to any employee whose [accomplishment or written suggestion beyond the scope of his responsibility] <u>extra effort</u> contributes to the efficiency, economy or improvement of agency operations and results in actual cost savings to the agency <u>or</u> whose investment expertise significantly contributes to increased returns from the investment of public funds. Any <u>policy established pursuant to this subsection shall:</u>

(1) be in writing;

(2) provide the amount of the award that employees will receive if they achieve certain benchmarks; and

- C. An award pursuant to this section shall:
- (1) be paid only from [actual cost savings] the operating budget of the agency making the award;
- (2) be paid only on the payday immediately following the first full pay period succeeding the award or immediately prior to separation or transfer from the agency; and
- (3) be paid one time [based on actual cost savings] in an amount determined in the agency's policy, not to exceed the lesser of:
- (a) [two thousand dollars (\$2,000)] three thousand dollars (\$3,000); or
- (b) an amount equal to ten percent of the actual cost savings <u>or increased returns</u> attributable to the employee in the twelve-month period immediately preceding the award or a lesser period preceding the award, if appropriate.
- D. Documentation substantiating awards pursuant to this section shall be submitted to the state personnel board which shall, as necessary or appropriate, prescribe regulations and review proposed awards made under this section and procedures used in making the awards to verify the cost savings for which the awards were made.
- E. The state personnel board shall report by September 1 of each year to the legislative finance committee
