17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
19	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
20	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
21	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding three hundred fifty
22	thousand dollars (\$350,000) when the local government division
23	of the department of finance and administration certifies the
24	need for the issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance
25	shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most

1 expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to 2 justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to 3 contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance 4 shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply 5 6 with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the 7 local government division for the purpose of planning, 8 9 purchasing land for and constructing a facility located in Rio 10 Arriba county to provide alcoholism and substance abuse recovery 11 services. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at 12 the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax 13 bonding fund. If the local government division has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of 14 15 fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section 16 shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
