17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
19	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
20	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
21	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one hundred thousand
22	five hundred dollars (\$100,500) when the department of
23	environment certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds.
24	The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale
25	of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner

1 possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the 2 project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. 3 The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 4 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 5 6 amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the department of environment for the purpose of 7 designing, constructing and inspecting the Canjilon mutual 8 9 domestic water consumers association community water system in 10 the community of Canjilon located in Rio Arriba county. Any 11 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of 12 fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. 13 If the department of environment has not certified the need for 14 the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the 15 authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
