	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS The state board of finance may issue

20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one hundred seventy-

1 bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed 2 sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can 3 proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 4 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 5 6 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 7 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the local government division of the department of finance and 8 9 administration for the purpose of designing, constructing, 10 equipping and furnishing of renovations and site improvements to 11 the Old North Valley community center located in Bernalillo 12 county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the 13 end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax 14 If the local government division of the bonding fund. 15 department of finance and administration has not certified the 16 need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 17 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
