AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO EXPAND AND ENHANCE PROGRAMS AT THE CLAYTON LIVESTOCK RESEARCH CENTER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Seventy-one thousand dollars (\$71,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of New Mexico state university for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of expanding and enhancing cooperative extension service programs at the Clayton livestock research Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred twelve thousand Section 2. dollars (\$112,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of New Mexico state university for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of expanding and enhancing

agricultural experiment station programs at the Clayton livestock research center. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
