AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX BONDS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN TULAROSA IN OTERO COUNTY; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--AUTHORIZATIONS--APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS.--

A. The state board of finance may issue and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the amounts authorized for purposes specified in Sections 2 through 5 of this act. The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance

and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated for the purposes specified in Sections 2 through 5 of this act.

- B. The agencies named in Sections 2 through 5 of this act shall certify to the state board of finance when the money from the proceeds of the severance tax bonds authorized in this section is needed for the purposes specified in the applicable section of this act.
- C. If the specified agency has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this act shall be void.
- D. Unless otherwise specified in this act, any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to Sections 2 through 5 of this act at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.

Section 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--DEPARTMENT OF
ENVIRONMENT--PURPOSES.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1
of this act, upon certification by the department of environment
that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the
following amounts are appropriated to the department of
environment for the following purposes in Tularosa in Otero

A. two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for planning, designing and constructing wastewater plant improvements, including sludge removal and disposal, rehabilitating existing aerators and adding a new lift station;

- B. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for water treatment plant improvements, including rehabilitating the existing water filter plant; and
- C. two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for phase five water line improvements, including replacing undersized water line valves and hydrants.

Section 3. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION--PURPOSES. --Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the local government division of the department of finance and administration that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated to the local government division for the following purposes in Tularosa in Otero county:

- A. one hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$130,000) for improving the community center, including remodeling and furnishing;
- B. three hundred five thousand dollars (\$305,000) to plan, design, construct, furnish or equip the police department building;
 - C. one hundred eighty-seven thousand five hundred

dollars (\$187,500) to plan, design, renovate and furnish the municipal offices; and

six hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$675,000) to purchase equipment and furnish the medical facility.

Section 4. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT -- PURPOSES. -- Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the general services department that the need exists for the issuance of bonds, three hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$320,000) is appropriated to the general services department to purchase yard equipment, including a front-end loader, a backhoe and a welder asphalt cutter in Tularosa in Otero county.

SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--STATE HIGHWAY AND Section 5. TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT--PURPOSE. --Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the state highway and transportation department that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, four hundred twenty-two thousand dollars (\$422,000) is appropriated to the state highway and transportation department for the purpose of street improvements in Tularosa located in Otero county.

EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public Section 6. peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
