# AN ACT

RELATING TO JUVENILE JUSTICE; ESTABLISHING A BOOT CAMP PROGRAM FOR CERTAIN DELINQUENT OFFENDERS; ENACTING A NEW SECTION OF THE DELINQUENCY ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the Delinquency Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] BOOT CAMP PROGRAM - ADMINISTRATION - - CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS. - -

A. The department shall develop and implement a boot camp program for certain delinquent offenders pursuant to the provisions of this section. The boot camp program shall include substance abuse counseling and treatment programs, general education diploma preparatory classes, manual labor assignments, physical training activities and personal development training.

The boot camp program shall be conducted in a strict disciplinary environment. The department shall require that participants in the boot camp program complete a structured, six-month program.

- B. Participation in the boot camp program shall be limited to certain delinquent offenders adjudicated on or after July 1, 1997. Individuals eligible to participate in the program are adjudicated delinquent offenders who are thirteen years of age or older.
- C. The department shall develop and adopt regulations to provide for screening of all adjudicated delinquent offenders for the purpose of determining eligibility to participate in the boot camp program. The regulations shall provide that the screening occurs within thirty days of an individual's adjudication as a delinquent offender. Subsequent to the screening, the department may recommend to the court that a delinquent offender be assigned to participate in the boot camp program.
- D. If the court accepts the department's recommendation, the delinquent offender shall be transferred to the custody of the department for the purpose of participating in the boot camp program.
- E. The department shall develop and adopt regulations regarding criteria for successful completion of the boot camp program. The regulations shall also provide for

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appropriate disposition of delinquent offenders who successfully complete the program and for those offenders who fail to successfully complete the program. The department shall notify the court in writing when a participant in the boot camp program successfully completes or fails to complete the program.

F. The department may contract with a public or private entity for the lease of a facility to house a boot camp program. The boot camp program shall be operated and administered by the department."
