19	A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
20	severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding
21	Act in an amount not exceeding eight million eight hundred
22	forty-eight thousand eight hundred dollars (\$8,848,800) when the
23	board of regents of western New Mexico university certifies the
24	need for the issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance
25	shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most

1 expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to 2 justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to 3 contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance 4 shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply 5 6 with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 7 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the board of regents of western New Mexico university in the 8 9 following amounts for the following purposes: 10 five million four hundred three thousand (1) dollars (\$5,403,000) for the design and construction of a center 11 12 for information technology at western New Mexico university

(2) one million four hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$1,420,000) to design, renovate or remodel the fine arts auditorium at western New Mexico university located in Grant county;

(3) four hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$425,000) to purchase and improve property for additional parking and future expansion at western New Mexico university located in Grant county;
