15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. Section 21-8-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1889,
17	Chapter 138, Section 19, as amended) is amended to read:
18	"21-8-1. <u>PURPOSE AND CHARACTER OF NEW MEXICO STATE</u>
19	<u>UNIVERSITY</u> [SEC. 112. The] New Mexico [College of Agriculture]
20	and Mechanic Arts] state university shall be an institution of
21	learning open to the children of all the residents of this state
22	and <u>to</u> such other persons as the board of regents may determine,
23	under such terms, rules and regulations as may be prescribed by
24	[said] <u>the</u> board of regents. <u>The university</u> shall be
25	nonsectarian in character and devoted to practical instruction

in agriculture and veterinary science, mechanic arts and natural sciences connected therewith, as well as a thorough course of instruction in all branches of learning bearing upon agriculture and other industrial pursuits."

Section 2. Section 21-8-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1889, Chapter 138, Section 20, as amended) is amended to read:

CURRICULUM - BOARD OF REGENTS - - NUMBER - -<u>QUALIFICATIONS--QUORUM</u> -- The course of instruction of [the college hereby created] <u>New Mexico state university</u> shall embrace the English language, literature, mathematics, philosophy, civil engineering, chemistry, [and] animal and vegetable anatomy and physiology, <u>veterinary medicine and</u> the veterinary art, entomology, geology, [and] political, rural and household economy, horticulture, moral philosophy, history, mechanics and such other sciences and courses of instruction as shall be prescribed by the board of regents of [this institution of learning] <u>New Mexico state university</u>. The management of [said college] the university and experiment station, the care and preservation of all property of which [such institution] the university shall become possessed, the erection and construction of all buildings necessary for the use of [said college] the university and station and the disbursement and expenditure of all [moneys] money provided for by [this act] law shall be vested in a board of five regents. [Said] The five regents shall possess the same qualifications [as] required for the

regents of the university of New Mexico. [Said] The regents [and their successors in office] shall constitute a body corporate with the name and style of the [The] regents of [the] New Mexico [College of agriculture and mechanic arts] state university, with the right as such of suing and being sued, [of] contracting and being contracted with, [of] making and using a common seal and altering the same at pleasure [of] and causing all things to be done necessary to carry out the provisions of law. A majority of the board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, but a [less] lesser number may adjourn from time to time."

Section 3. APPROPRIATION. -- Three hundred million dollars (\$300,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of New Mexico state university for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of establishing, making capital expenditures for and operating a school of veterinary medicine at the main campus of New Mexico state university in Las Cruces. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 1997.
