AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO FUND THE UNITED STATES-MEXICO LAW INSTITUTE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO SCHOOL OF LAW; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of the university of New Mexico for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and 1998 for the purpose of funding the United States-Mexico law institute, an international organization that studies the legal relationship between the United States and Mexico and is headquartered at the university of New Mexico school of law. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public
