AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES: AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX BONDS FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS IN CIBOLA COUNTY; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SEVERANCE TAX BONDS -- AUTHORIZATIONS --Section 1. APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS. --

The state board of finance may issue and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the amounts authorized for purposes specified in Sections 2 and 3 of this The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board

of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

Proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated for the purposes specified in Sections 2 and 3 of this act.

- B. The agencies named in Sections 2 and 3 of this act shall certify to the state board of finance when the money from the proceeds of the severance tax bonds authorized in this section is needed for the purposes specified in the applicable section of this act.
- C. If the specified agency has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this act shall be void.
- D. Unless otherwise specified in this act, any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to Sections 2 and 3 of this act at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.

Section 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION--PURPOSES.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the local government division of the department of finance and administration that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for the following purposes:

- A. thirty-two thousand dollars (\$32,000) to resurface existing tennis courts at Paddy Martinez park in Grants located in Cibola county;
- B. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase, relocate, set up and carpet two portable buildings for the headstart program in Grants located in Cibola county;
- C. one million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$1,800,000) to purchase a new water tank and to restore the existing water tank in Grants located in Cibola county;
- D. seven hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$720,000) for water, sewer and street improvements for the Gaboldon Hill area in Grants located in Cibola county;
- E. three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to upgrade the domestic water system in Bluewater Acres located in Cibola county; and
- F. one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000) to plan and design a detention facility in the pueblo of Laguna located in Cibola county.
- Section 3. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION--PURPOSES.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the state department of public education that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated to the state department of public education for the following purposes:
  - A. thirty-two thousand dollars (\$32,000) for

improvements to and resurfacing of existing tennis courts at Los Alamos middle school in Grants located in Cibola county; and
