14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	Section 1. Section 21-5-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1903,
16	Chapter 2, Section 6, as amended) is amended to read:
17	"21-5-2. MANAGEMENT OF [STATE INSTITUTIONS] NEW MEXICO
18	SCHOOL FOR THE VISUALLY HANDICAPPED - CORPORATE POWERS
19	A. The management and control of the New Mexico
20	school for the visually handicapped, the care and preservation
21	of all property of which it shall become possessed, the erection
22	and construction of all buildings necessary for its use and the
23	disbursement and expenditure of all [moneys] money appropriated
24	by the state of New Mexico or [which] that shall otherwise come
25	into $[its]$ the school's possession shall be vested in a board of

five [trustees. The incumbent trustees shall remain in office for the remainder of their present terms. Said Trustees shall possess the same qualifications, shall be appointed in the same manner, and their terms of office shall be the same and the vacancies therein shall be filled in the same manner, as is provided with reference to the regents of the university of New Mexico. Said trustees regents, at least one of whom shall be visually handicapped, at least one other of whom shall be the parent of a visually handicapped child and at least two others of whom shall be the spouse, brother, sister, daughter or son of a visually handicapped person. No more than one regent shall reside in Otero county.

B. The regents and their successors in office shall constitute a body corporate under the name and style of "the [trustees] board of regents of the New Mexico school for the visually handicapped". [with] The board has the right as such of suing and being sued, of contracting and being contracted with, of making and using a common seal and altering the same at pleasure and of causing all things to be done necessary to carry out the provisions of [this] Chapter 21, Article 5 NMSA 1978. A majority of the board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, but a [less] smaller number may adjourn from time to time. The officers of the board shall be elected in the same manner and possess the same qualifications as the officers of the board of regents of the university of New Mexico

in a reasonable amount set by the board, of all officers and
employees who have custody of or handle funds of the -
institutions conditioned on the faithful performance of their
duties. The governor shall be ex officio a member of the board
but shall not have the right to vote or be eligible to officd.'
