16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one hundred twenty-
21	four thousand four hundred dollars ( $\$124,400$ ) when the state
22	highway and transportation department certifies the need for the
23	issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall
24	schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most
25	expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the

board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance 3 shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. 5 The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the state highway and transportation department for the purpose of placing base course and asphalt on county roads 270, 271 and 273 8 in Las Tablas, county roads 274 and 284 in Petaca and county 10 roads 250, 251 and 257 in Vallecitos located in Rio Arriba 11 county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the 12 end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax 13 bonding fund. If the state highway and transportation 14 department has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void.

EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public Section 2. peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
