AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS; PROVIDING A MINIMUM SALARY FOR
CONTRACT SCHOOL MEAL PREPARATION PERSONNEL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 22-10-27 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1994,
Chapter 95, Section 1) is amended to read:

"22-10-27. NONCERTIFIED SCHOOL AND CONTRACT PERSONNEL - -
SALARIES. - -Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 50-4-22
NMSA 1978, a local school district shall pay a minimum wage rate
of six dollars (\$6.00) per hour to all noncertified school
personnel and contract school meal preparation personnel. "
