17	Section 1. A new section of the Liquor Control Act is

19	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL]</u> SALE OF KEGS OF BEER PROHIBITEDIt is a
20	violation of the Liquor Control Act for a retailer to sell a keg
21	of beer for consumption off the licensed premises. As used in
22	this section, "keg" means a package of beer containing more than
23	six gallons of beer at the time it is sold."
24	Section 2. REPEALSection 60-7B-12 NMSA 1978 (being Laws
25	1989, Chapter 140, Section 1) is repealed.
