#### AN ACT

RELATING TO WELFARE REFORM; PROVIDING THAT LEGAL IMMIGRANTS AND UNDOCUMENTED IMMIGRANTS RECEIVE CERTAIN SERVICES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. SOCIAL AND EDUCATION SERVICES--PROVIDED TO LEGAL AND UNDOCUMENTED IMMIGRANTS.--

A. Legal immigrants shall be eligible to receive the following services and programs from the state:

- (1) emergency medical and health services;
- (2) Title 20 social services;
- (3) state child care assistance;
- (4) women, infants and children nutrition programs and other commodity benefits; and
  - (5) child and adult care food programs.
  - B. Undocumented immigrants shall be eligible to

receive health services from the state.

C. Immigrants may participate in the child and adult care food program administered by the children, youth and families department. The state shall opt out of enforcing immigration restrictions on participation in the program.
