(1) of a fourth degree felony if the property
[is a vehicle or has a value in excess of one hundred dollars
(\$100)] or vehicle has a value of less than two thousand five
hundred dollars (\$2.500):

(2) of a third degree felony if the property or vehicle has a value of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) or more but less than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000);

(3) of a second degree felony if the vehicle has a value of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) or more; and $\left[\frac{(2)}{(4)}\right]$ of a petty misdemeanor if the property is not a vehicle and has a value of one hundred dollars (\$100) or less.

Failure of the lessee to return the vehicle or personal property to the place specified within seventy-two hours after the mailing to him by certified mail at his address shown on the leasing agreement of a written demand to return the vehicle or personal property shall raise a rebuttable presumption that the failure to return the vehicle or personal property was with intent to defraud."
