18	"66-3-705. RIDING ON ROADWAYS AND BICYCLE PATHS
19	A. Every person operating a bicycle upon a roadway
20	shall ride as near to the right side of the roadway as
21	[praticable] <u>practicable</u> , exercising due care when passing a
22	standing vehicle or one proceeding in the same direction.
23	B. [Person] <u>Persons</u> riding bicycles upon a roadway
24	shall not ride more than two abreast except on paths or parts of
25	roadways set aside for the exclusive use of bicycles.

	1	[C. Whenever a usable path for bicycles has been
	2	provided adjacent to a roadway, bicycle riders shall use such
