AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR AN EROSION CONTROL PROGRAM IN TAOS COUNTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and 1998 for the purpose of establishing an erosion control and re-seeding program in areas damaged by fire in Taos county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. --It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
