AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR SUPPORT OF THE BILINGUAL PROGRAM AT
WASHINGTON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN LAS CRUCES; DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --Twelve thousand dollars
(\$12,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state
department of public education for expenditure in fiscal years
1997 and 1998 for the purpose of purchasing educational
materials for the bilingual multicultural education program at
Washington elementary school in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county.
Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. --It is necessary for the public
peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
