1 upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can 2 proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 3 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 4 5 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 6 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the state department of public education for the purpose of 7 acquiring and installing educational technology for Eugene Field 8 9 elementary located in Bernalillo county. Any unexpended or 10 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 11 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the state 12 department of public education has not certified the need for 13 the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the 14 authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
