AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPROVING, MONITORING AND ASSESSING HEALTH CONDITIONS AND HEALTH RISKS IN THE SAN JOSE COMMUNITY LOCATED IN BERNALILLO COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

APPROPRIATION. -- Three hundred thousand dollars Section 1. (\$300,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of health for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of conducting a monitoring and assessment program, with the San Jose community awareness council, inc., to study health conditions and to reduce environmental health risks to improve the quality of life in the San Jose community of Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county. This monitoring and assessing will assist in developing a health risk profile and will include maintaining a long-term database. Any unexpended or

unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
