AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR CHILD AND FAMILY COUNSELING SERVICES RELATED TO DOMESTIC VIOLENCE THROUGH THE CROWNPOINT HEALTH CARE FACILITY IN MCKINLEY COUNTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the mental health division of the department of health for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and 1998 for the purpose of providing child and family counseling services related to domestic violence, including a twenty-four-hour crisis hotline, through the Crownpoint health care facility located in McKinley county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public

peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
