appropriated from the general fund to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and 1998 to enable the northwest New Mexico council of governments to support the efforts of the economic development district that is designated by the federal economic development administration to serve the counties of San Juan, Cibola and McKinley in the district's efforts to establish community-based economic development.
