17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding thirty-two thousand
20 21	dollars (\$32,000) when the state agency on aging certifies the
22	need for the issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance
23	shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most
23 24	expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the

justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to 1 contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance 2 shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply 3 with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 4 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the 5 state agency on aging for the purpose of purchasing a new senior 6 citizen van for the Nenahnezad chapter of the Navajo nation 7 located in San Juan county. Any unexpended or unencumbered 8 balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to 9 the severance tax bonding fund. If the state agency on aging 10 has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the 11 end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this 12 section shall be void. 13 Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public 14

peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
