sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can 1 proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 2 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 3 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 4 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the New 5 Mexico office of Indian affairs for the purpose of providing 6 replacement work for the Yellowman siphon irrigation pipe system 7 near the Nenahnezad chapter area located in San Juan county. 8 Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of 9 fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. 10 If the New Mexico office of Indian affairs has not certified the 11 need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 12 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void. 13 Section 2.
