MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR AN EDUCATIONAL TRANSITION PILOT
PROJECT IN DULCE IN RIO ARRIBA COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Seventy thousand four hundred
dollars (\$70,400) is appropriated from the general fund to the
New Mexico office of Indian affairs for expenditure in fiscal
year 1998 for the purpose of providing an educational transition
pilot project to aid high school graduates seeking to continue
their educations. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the
general fund.
