19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one hundred thousand
21	dollars (\$100,000) when the New Mexico office of Indian affairs
22	certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state
23	board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the
24	bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible
25	upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed

1 sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 2 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 3 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 4 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the New 5 6 Mexico office of Indian affairs for the purpose of planning for a long-term intermediate care facility in Beclabito located in 7 Any unexpended or unencumbered balance 8 San Juan county. 9 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the 10 severance tax bonding fund. If the New Mexico office of Indian 11 affairs has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds 12 by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in 13 this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
