AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES: AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX BONDS FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS AT EASTERN NEW MEXICO UNIVERSITY IN ROSWELL IN CHAVES COUNTY; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SEVERANCE TAX BONDS -- PURPOSES FOR WHICH Section 1. ISSUED--APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS. --

The state board of finance may issue and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one million five hundred fiftyseven thousand fifty dollars (\$1,557,050) when the board of regents of eastern New Mexico university certifies the need for The state board of finance shall the issuance of the bonds. schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most

expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the board of regents of eastern New Mexico university in the following amounts for the following purposes in Chaves county:

- (\$750,000) for a two-way interactive video delivery system for one on-campus and six remote sites located in area public schools:
- (2) three hundred thirty-five thousand dollars (\$335,000) for a telephone system upgrade to accommodate current needs and future expansion;
- (3) one hundred twenty-eight thousand eight hundred dollars (\$128,800) for an upgrade of instructional and administrative computing in conjunction with proposed software conversion;
- (4) seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to equip the physical and biological science laboratories to provide virtual laboratory experiences and access to the internet:
 - (5) sixty-three thousand seven hundred fifty

dollars (\$63,750) for five self-contained multimedia classrooms, one for each of the instructional divisions;

- (6) sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) to upgrade equipment to accommodate the state-of-the-art drafting curriculum to provide instructional software to match local industry needs;
- (7) fifty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$57,500) to provide equipment to facilitate multilevel student learning styles in English and foreign language instruction;
- (\$42,500) for start-up equipment for a respiratory therapy program;
- (9) twenty-three thousand five hundred dollars (\$23,500) for video equipment for the production of promotional material;
- (10) eleven thousand dollars (\$11,000) for a rescue airbag set for an emergency medical services program; and
- (11) ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for a microfiche reader and printer for use by students in the learning resource center.
- B. If the board of regents of eastern New Mexico university has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from the proceeds of severance tax bonds

issued pursuant to Subsection A of this section at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.

EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public Section 2. peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
