AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and 1998 for the purpose of hiring additional staff for planning and community needs at the Nenahnezad chapter in San Juan county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
