17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding four thousand dollars
21	($\$4,000$) when the local government division of the department of
22	finance and administration certifies the need for the issuance
23	of the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the
24	issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and
25	economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the

1 project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable 2 The state board of finance shall further take the 3 time. appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue 4 Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the 5 6 bonds are appropriated to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for the purpose of 7 purchasing resource materials for a grant writing library 8 9 serving San Miguel, Colfax and Mora counties. Any unexpended or 10 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 11 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the local 12 government division of the department of finance and 13 administration has not certified the need for the issuance of 14 the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization 15 provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
