AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS IN SENATE DISTRICT 6.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS. --

A. Four thousand dollars (\$4,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for a resource library in Mora county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

B. Forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 to review and update and provide for

implementation and enforcement of the Mora county land use code and comprehensive land use plan. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

- C. Seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the local government division of the department of finance and administration to improve the ice hockey facility and purchase safety equipment and reusable supplies for ice hockey in Taos county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
- D. One hundred eighty-nine thousand dollars (\$189,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of the university of New Mexico for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for operating expenses of the Harwood museum and northern new Mexico research center. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
- E. Forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the economic development department for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for a pilot project in Taos county to train welfare recipients in food production technology. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
 - F. Forty-seven thousand dollars (\$47,000) is

appropriated from the general fund to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 to provide internet access for Questa, Questa school district and Penasco. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
