11	RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF
12	SEVERANCE TAX BONDS FOR ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS IN DONA ANA
13	COUNTY; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSES FOR WHICH
17	ISSUEDAPPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS
18	A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
19	severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding
20	Act in an amount not exceeding nine hundred ninety thousand
21	dollars (\$990,000) when the state highway and transportation
22	department certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds.
23	The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale
24	of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner
25	possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been

1	developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the
2	project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The
3	state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps
4	necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as
5	amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are
6	appropriated to the state highway and transportation department
7	in the following amounts for the following purposes:
8	(1) one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
9	reconstruct one-half mile of Corona road between Moongate and
10	Weisner road in Dona Ana county;
11	(2) thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) to
12	reblade and apply double penetration surfacing on one and one-
13	half miles of MacArthur road in the Moongate area in Dona Ana
14	county;
15	(3) one hundred fifty thousand dollars
16	(\$150,000) to resurface and construct improvements to streets in
17	the Butterfield park area of East mesa in Dona Ana county;
18	(4) one hundred fifty thousand dollars
19	(\$150,000) to resurface and construct improvements to two miles
20	of streets in Organ in Dona Ana county;
21	(5) one hundred fifty thousand dollars
22	(\$150,000) to reconstruct one mile of Rincon and MacArthur in
23	Dona Ana county;
24	(6) two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to
25	surface and improve two and two-thirds miles of Moongate D-069

2 (7) one hundred sixty thousand dollars
3 (\$160,000) to reconstruct eight-tenths of one mile of Kissiah
4 drive in Dona Ana county; and

(8) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to acquire rights-of-way for the East mesa loop between United States highway 70 and the Mesquite interstate 10 interchange.

B. If the state highway and transportation
department has not certified the need for the issuance of the
bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided
in this section shall be void. Any unexpended or unencumbered
balance remaining from the proceeds of severance tax bonds
issued pursuant to Subsection A of this section at the end of
fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.
Section 2. EMERGENCY. --It is necessary for the public
peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
