17	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
18	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
19	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding four hundred fifty-
20	seven thousand three hundred twenty dollars (\$457,320) when the
21	New Mexico office of Indian affairs certifies the need for the
22	issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall
23	schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most
24	expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the
25	board that the project has been developed sufficiently to

1 justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance 2 shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply 3 with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 4 5 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the New 6 Mexico office of Indian affairs for the purpose of planning, designing or constructing new head start centers at Red Lake 7 chapter and Coal Mine located in McKinley county. 8 Any 9 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of 10 fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. 11 If the New Mexico office of Indian affairs has not certified the 12 need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 13 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void. 14 Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public

peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
