18	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
19	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one million dollars
20	(\$1,000,000) when the state highway and transportation
21	department certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds.
22	The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale
23	of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner
24	possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been

1 project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 2 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 3 amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are 4 appropriated to the state highway and transportation department 5 6 for the purpose of replacing Hassler valley bridge on county 7 road 43 located in McKinley county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 8 9 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the state 10 highway and transportation department has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, 11 12 the authorization provided in this section shall be void. 13 Section 2.
