16	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
17	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
18	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
19	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one hundred sixty-
20	five thousand dollars (\$165,000) when the state highway and
21	transportation department certifies the need for the issuance of
22	the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the
23	issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and
24	economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the
25	project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance

1 and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the 2 appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue 3 Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the 4 5 bonds are appropriated to the state highway and transportation 6 department for the purpose of paving county roads near Arroyo Hondo located in Santa Fe county. Any unexpended or 7 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 8 9 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the state 10 highway and transportation department has not certified the need 11 for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, 12 the authorization provided in this section shall be void. 13 Section 2.
