18	"27-5-7.1. COUNTY INDIGENT HOSPITAL CLAIMS FUND
19	AUTHORIZED USES OF THE FUND
20	A. The fund shall be used:
21	(1) to meet the county's contribution for
22	support of sole community provider payments as calculated by the
23	department for that county; and
24	(2) to pay all claims that have been approved
25	by the board that are not matched with federal funds under the
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1	state medicaid program.
2	B. The fund may be used to meet the county's
3	obligation under Section 27-10-4 NMSA 1978.

7	<u>C. In a county with a critical shortage of general</u>
8	practitioners, the fund may be used to reimburse a hospital or
9	health care provider for payments made to ensure the continued
10	<u>availability of a general practitioner, residing and working in</u>
11	<u>the county, to provide medical services to the indigent of the</u>
12	<u>county.</u> "
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
