1 developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. 2 The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 3 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 4 The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are 5 amended. 6 appropriated to the state highway and transportation department for the purpose of making improvements, including gravel 7 surfacing, to five miles of county road 57 in the Rock Springs 8 9 chapter area located in McKinley county. Any unexpended or 10 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the state 11 12 highway and transportation department has not certified the need 13 for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, 14 the authorization provided in this section shall be void. 15 Section 2.
