Section 1. Section 72-16-20 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1963,

"72-16-20. IMPLEMENTING POWERSThe board may:
A. acquire, improve, equip, maintain and operate any
project or facility for the control of flood and storm waters of
the authority and the flood and storm waters of streams $[$ which $]$
that have their sources outside of the authority but which
streams and the flood waters thereof flow into the authority;

1	B. protect from such floods or storm waters the
2	water courses, watersheds, public highways, life and property in
3	the authority;
4	C. exercise the right of eminent domain, either
5	within or without the authority, in the manner provided by law
6	for the condemnation of private property for public use; <u>and</u>
7	D. as to flood control and drainage projects only,
8	exercise those powers granted to counties in the County
9	<u>Improvement District Act</u> ."
