16	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
17	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
18	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
19	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one hundred thousand
20	dollars (\$100,000) when the state highway and transportation
21	department certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds.
22	The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale
23	of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner
24	possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been
25	developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the

1 project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 2 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 3 amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are 4 appropriated to the state highway and transportation department 5 6 for the purpose of graveling and paving approximately one mile of a road that runs easterly across United States 666 from the 7 New Mexico state highway and transportation department located 8 9 in McKinley county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance 10 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the 11 severance tax bonding fund. If the state highway and 12 transportation department has not certified the need for the 13 issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the 14 authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
