RELATING TO TAXATION; AMENDING THE SPECIAL FUELS SUPPLIER TAX

ACT TO PROVIDE A CREDIT FOR PRODUCING CERTAIN FUELS BY

ALTERNATIVE MEANS; ENACTING A NEW SECTION OF THE NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the Special Fuels Supplier Tax Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] ALTERNATIVE FEEDSTOCK CREDIT. --

A. Prior to January 1, 2009, any person who produces diesel fuel, naphtha and kerosene for sale from feedstock that is at least ninety percent natural gas may claim, and the department may allow, a credit in an amount specified in Subsection B of this section. The credit shall be claimed on forms and in the manner specified by the department. The credit authorized by this section may be referred to as the

"alternative feedstock credit".

- B. The alternative feedstock credit is an amount equal to the difference between eighty-five cents per gallon and the average price for the report period for diesel fuel times the number of diesel fuel gallons produced from alternative feedstock and sold during the report period. The amount of the credit per gallon shall not exceed the rate of the special fuel excise tax for the report period.
- C. As used in this section, "average price" means the average price per gallon, truncated to the nearest whole cent, of No. 2 diesel fuel reported in "refiner prices of petroleum products to end users" in the publication, Monthly Energy Review, published by the energy information administration, or any successor index or publication.
- D. The department shall keep records of the amounts of credit allowed to each person claiming the alternative feedstock credit and the amounts of any credit repayments made under Subsection E of this section by that person.
- E. Except as provided otherwise in this subsection, any person who has been allowed alternative feedstock credits shall repay the amount of credit allowed whenever the average price exceeds eighty-five cents per gallon. The repayment is an amount equal to the difference between the average price and eighty-five cents times the number of gallons of diesel produced from alternative feedstock and sold during the report period.

Repayment is due by the twenty-fifth of the month following the month in which the average price is published. The amount of repayment made or due under this subsection shall not exceed the total amount of unrepaid alternative feedstock credits allowed. The department may assess as tax any repayment amount due but not paid timely.

F. Any alternative feedstock credit based on a reporting period ending prior to January 1, 2009 may be claimed and allowed through December 31, 2009."

Section 2. The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 1997.
