RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; CLARIFYING THE PURPOSE AND EXTENDING THE EXPENDITURE PERIOD OF A GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION FOR A SOUTHSIDE COMMUNITY CENTER IN HOBBS; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. GENERAL FUND--CLARIFYING THE PURPOSE--EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIOD--APPROPRIATION.--The balance of the general fund appropriation made pursuant to Subsection SSSSS of Section 24 of Chapter 222 of Laws 1995 to design, construct, furnish and equip a southside community center in Hobbs in Lea county shall be expended to design, construct, furnish and equip a southside senior citizen center and multipurpose center in the city of Hobbs. The period of time for expenditure of the appropriation is extended through fiscal year 2000. Any

unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the general fund.

EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public Section 2. peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
