### AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM
THE STATE ROAD FUND TO ACQUIRE LAND AND PROVIDE A PORT-OF-ENTRY
FACILITY NEAR SANTA TERESA LOCATED IN DONA ANA COUNTY; DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. STATE ROAD FUND--APPROPRIATION.--Seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000) is appropriated from the state road fund to the property control division of the general services department for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 through 2001 for the purpose of acquiring land, purchasing a modular office building and equipping a port-of-entry facility near Santa Teresa located in Dona Ana county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2001 shall revert to the state road fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
