AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO FOR SPECIAL PROJECTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Five hundred ninety-five thousand dollars (\$595,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of the university of New Mexico for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the following projects in the following amounts:

- (1) three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for recruitment of academically exceptional graduate students to improve the quality and quantity of research work done at the university of New Mexico; and
 - (2) two hundred ninety-five thousand dollars

(\$295,000) for the art of the Americas institute to conduct teaching, research and public service projects and promote cultural diversity in the arts.

Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining B. at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
