AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS OF SUPREME COURT FACILITIES; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000) is appropriated from the supreme court building addition reserve fund, account number 3-220.0, fund 402 and supreme court building addition interest and retirement fund, account number 1-220.0, fund 860 to the supreme court building commission for expenditure in 1998 and subsequent fiscal years for the purpose of defraying expenses related to capital improvements of supreme court facilities. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall not revert.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public
