BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. HEALTH CARE DATA BOARD--CREATED--POWERS AND

- A. The "health care data board" is created. The board shall be composed of one representative of:
- (1) the New Mexico health policy commission, appointed by the chairman of the commission;
- (2) the department of health, appointed by the secretary of health;
- (3) the human services department, appointed by he secretary of human services;

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(5) the workers' compensation administration,	
appointed by the director of the administration;	
(6) the children, youth and families	
department, appointed by the secretary of children, youth and	
families;	
(7) the New Mexico hospital association,	
appointed by the director of the association;	
(8) health maintenance organizations, appointed

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- (2) develop a high-level data architecture for health information in the state; and
- (3) begin development of a data system for secure exchange of electronic data among health organizations.
- C. Members of the board who are not state employees or otherwise reimbursed for expenses may receive per diem and mileage pursuant to the Per Diem and Mileage Act.
- D. Staff for the board shall be furnished by the office on information and communication management, the New Mexico health policy commission and other state agencies as requested.
- E. The board shall report quarterly to the New Mexico health policy commission, the appropriate legislative committees and the health information alliance.
 - F. The board shall function until July 1, 1999.
- Section 2. APPROPRIATION. -- Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the office on information and communication management for expenditure in fiscal years 1998 and 1999 to implement the health care data system. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
- Section 3. DELAYED REPEAL. -- This act is repealed effective July 1, 1999.
 - Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the

provisions of this act is July 1, 1997.

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
